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### College Feedback System

The college collects feedback from different stakeholder – Teachers, students, and alumni. The procedure for collecting feedback is as under

1. Student - at the end of every academic year feedback is collected from students on a prescribed format on the course studied during the semester.
2. Faculty - at the end of every academic year feedback is collected from teaching faculty on a prescribed format on the course taught by the faculty.
3. Alumni - at the end of every academic year feedback is collected from alumni at alumni meet on a prescribed format on the curriculum.

The collage IQAC handles the entire processes of collecting feedback from stakeholders. The data is analyzed and suggestions are considered for discussion and their possible incorporation in the collage curriculum.

The stakeholders are supplied with a MCQ style Questionnaires and their responses are recorded. The responses are then processed and analyzed statistically to obtain the Feedback Analysis Report.

**Submission**

The Feedback Analysis Report is discussed with advisory committee members, IQAC and Principal for necessary suggestions.

**Action Taken**

Finally, proper suggestions were consolidated and communicated to the BOS members and syllabus revision committee members of university to ensure the proper redressal of grievances if any.

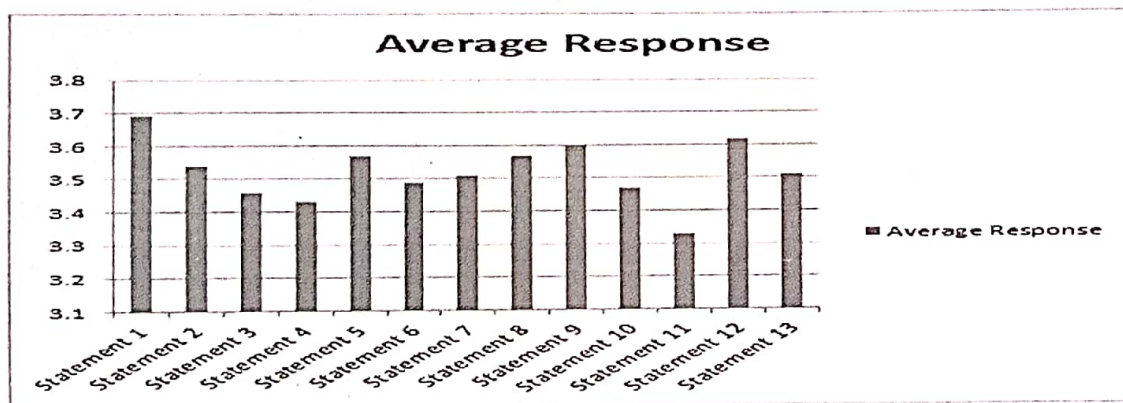
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

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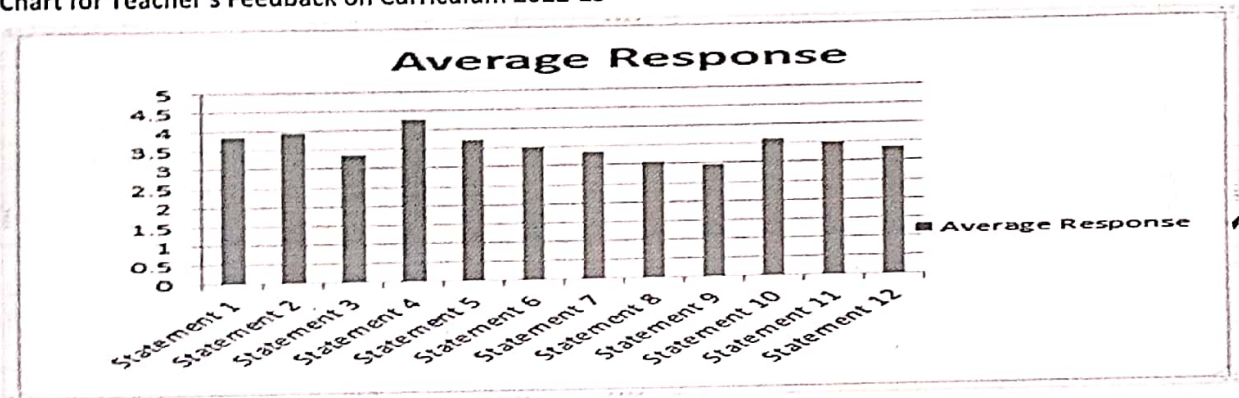

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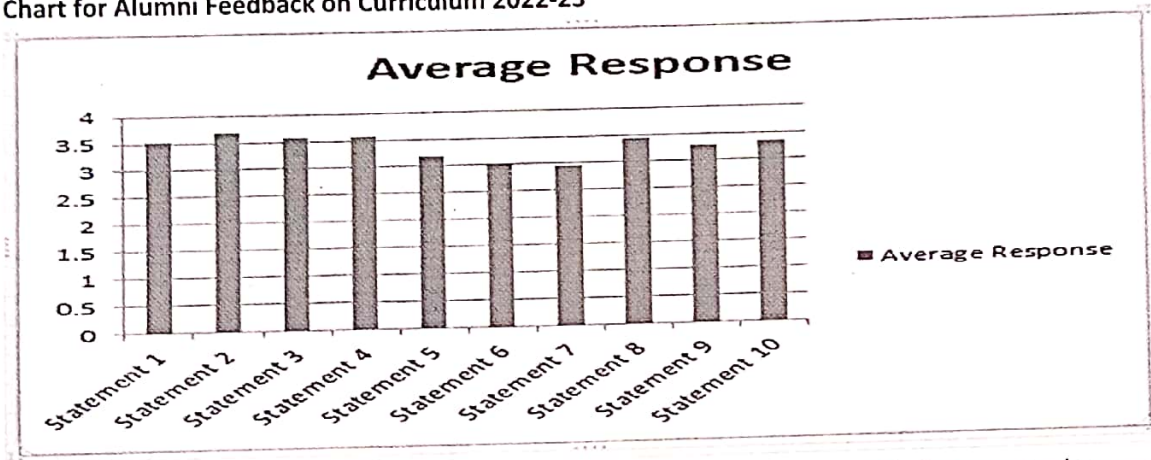


**Chart for Alumni Feedback on Curriculum 2022-23**


