




# One Day Regional Conference on

The concept of sustainable development first emerged in the 1960s when environmentalists started debating on the impact of economic growth on the environment. Since then, different views of sustainability and sustainable development have been put forward and discussed, but the most widely adopted one was published in the report, "Our Common Future" (also known as the Brundtland Report) by the World Commission on Environment and Development in 1987, which defined sustainable development as: "Development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs." Sustainable development calls for concerted efforts towards building an inclusive, sustainable and resilient future for people and planet.

For sustainable development to be achieved, it is crucial to harmonise three core elements: economic growth, social inclusion and environmental protection. These elements are interconnected and are all crucial for the well-being of individuals and societies.
